
### Coordinated Entry System Refinements

#### Quarter 1 CES

- Case Conferencing revamp work group developed new practices and updated policies around case conferencing, and new process was launched in April 2021

- Established new work group and workplan to develop a new housing needs assessment tool to replace the VI-SPDAT




## Strategic Priority 2 & 3
